We are a small community of nurses, doulas and perinatal care advocates who provide free virtual and in-person support services to BIPOC moms and birthing persons who cannot afford it.

In addition, we provide educational offerings to vulnerable populations who do not traditionally seek out perinatal support because of lack of access, information, and funds. These populations include immigrant and refugee communities, the prison population, teen parents, and pregnant victims of human trafficking/domestic violence.

In our beginning stages we are focusing on engaging communities, their leaders and partners to educate the public about maternal and infant mortality disparities, what perinatal support is, and why it is so important to marginalized communities to have prenatal, birthing and postnatal support. Our ultimate goal is to become a thriving perinatal support services agency offering services to the communities that need it most at no cost to them, while providing a living wage for the birth workers and advocates doing this important work.
